

# PLEASE READ!

## How Karaoke Works...



Karaoke is a lot of fun and everybody wants to get their sing on. In general, most karaoke shows run about the same way. However, there are a few differences from KJ to KJ. Before we get started, here is how my karaoke work. Just a few simply rules that everyone must follow for a smooth and fun filled show;

1. There is a start time and an end time. Each and every karaoke show is timed, by the computer, from the time it starts to the end of the evening. The computer begins computing time from the first song request entered.
2. Use the 2HYPE4U Karaoke Show SongBook to select your song. Then sign up using the request slips provided. SongBooks are updated monthly and are reprinted every 6 months. If you do not see a song that you know is available for karaoke, ask host if it is available in catalog. If not, host will try to have it available the following week.
3. The list fills up quickly, so you need to get your slips in as early as you can. Do not wait till the middle or near the end of the evening to signup. Please turn in one (1) slip at a time with your or your group's name. If you turn in more than one (1), only one (1) will be recognized. This is to try to assure fairness in rotation.
4. Once you are on the list, you will get a chance to sing. You may change your song as many times as you like up until the time you sing. The list does get long, so please be patient because there are others on the list ahead of you waiting to sing.
5. Please listen for your name to be called for your turn. If you are not available when called, your turn will be skipped and we will move on to the next person. See me (the host) when you return.
6. When on stage, please do not yell, scream, hit or drop the mic. Wireless mics are very sensitive.
7. If you want someone to sing with you, please add their name on the slip alone side yours to avoid confusion.
8. If you have not been invited to sing with the person singing, PLEASE do not join them on stage. This again will cut down on the confusion.
9. There is always a lot of activity going on around the KJ's area. So please keep in mind, the karaoke host can only do one thing at a time. Please wait to be acknowledged.
10. Most times near the middle to the end of the show, the list is usually full. At that time, the song list is closed. This means "***no more song requests are taken.***" Again, do not wait till the middle to the end of the evening to signup.
11. When the song list has been closed, please do not ask if I can take one more request because I can't. Please be considerate of the staff as well as myself that has been working all evening long serving you. All shows are timed to end at the end of the evening.
12. NOTE: I am a karaoke host with some dance music not a DJ. I do not have a host of regular music for play.
13. If you have any questions, please see me, the karaoke host.
